





Cochrane Collaboration

Cochrane Library databases (4)

- 1. Cochrane Database of Systematic Reviews (CDSR)
 - Full text systematic reviews ongoing and completed
 - Meta-analyses diagrams
- 2. Database of Abstracts of Reviews of Effectiveness (DARE)
 - Assessments of reviews
 - Focus on methodology

Cochrane Library databases

- 3. Cochrane Controlled Trials Register (CCTR)
- Bibliographic references to trials

- 4. Cochrane Review Methodology Database (CRMD)
- References to methodology studies

When should you use the Cochrane Library?

For questions on effectiveness

- What is the effectiveness of treatment x
- What is an effective treatment for y
- Is z effective in treating y
- Is z better than x at treating y

When not to use the Cochrane Library

- General healthcare questions
 - causal, prognosis, epidemiology, etc.
- Statistics (prevalence and incidence)
- Primary research other than RCTs
- Guidelines
- Current research

Cochrane Oral Health Review Group - Background

Aug 1996: UK Base established

Jul 1997: Funding secured

Feb 1998:Official opening

Sep 2000: 3 reviews, 19 protocols, 11 titles

Aug 2001: 5 reviews, 22 protocols, 20 titles

Include all randomised controlled trials of oral health broadly conceived to include the prevention, treatment and rehabilitation of oral, dental and craniofacial diseases and disorders



Reviews: phase 1: hand searching of the literature...




Undertaking a systematic review

- Register title
- Prepare protocol
- Editorial and external review of protocol
- Protocol entered on Cochrane Library
- Identify trials
- Complete systematic review
- Peer review of systematic review
- Systematic review entered on Library

Phase 2...literature search Systematic Review topic A **Cochrane Controlled Trials Register Systematic Review topic B** Medline Embase etc. **Systematic Review topic C**

Phase 3 ... selection of studies.

Completed reviews on Oral care in the Cochrane Library

- Orthodontic treatments for posterior crossbites
- Interventions for treating oral lichen planus
- Interventions for preventing oral mucositis or oral candidiasis for patients with cancer receiving chemotherapy (excluding head and neck cancer)
- Guided tissue regeneration for periodontal infrabony defects
- Potassium nitrate toothpaste for dentine hypersensitivity
- Interventions for the treatment of burning mouth syndrome

Protocols in Cochrane Library - examples

- Interventions for treating oral leukoplakia
- Interventions for replacing missing teeth with or without osseointegrated implants
- Interventions for treating oral mucositis or its associated pain for patients receiving chemotherapy and or radiotherapy
- Glues for fixing dental braces onto teeth

Protocols out to referees - examples

- Stabilisation splint therapy for temporomandibular pain dysfunction syndrome
- Hyaluronate for treating organic disorders of the TMJ
- Pharmacological treatments for fear/anxiety in patients undergoing routine dental procedures
 - Retention procedures for stabilising tooth position after treatment with orthodontic bra

Titles registered with OHG - examples

- Feeding interventions for infants with cleft lip, cleft palate or cleft lip and palate
- Fluoride therapy for the treatment of dental caries
- Pilocarpine for radiation induced xerostomy
- Therapeutic trials for recurrent (apthous) oral ulcer
- Fluorides for the prevention of enamel demineralisation during orthodontic treatment
