What are Systematic Reviews

- Clear statement of purpose and scope
- Comprehensive search and retrieval of the relevant research
- Explicit selection criteria
- Critical appraisal of the primary studies
- Reproducible decisions regarding relevance, selection, and methodologic rigor of the primary research
- When quantitative methodology applied -> meta-analysis

Prophylactic Removal of Impacted Third Molars: is it Justified?

- Third molar surgery rates vary widely across the UK.
- Around 35% of third molars removed for prophylactic purposes in the UK are disease free.
- Surgical removal of third molars can only be justified when clear long term benefit to the patient is expected.
- It is not possible to predict reliably whether impacted third molars will develop pathological changes if they are not removed.
- There are no randomised controlled studies to compare the long term outcome of early removal with retention of pathology free third molars.



Dental Restoration: What Type of Filling?

- Tooth decay is one of the most common diseases and accounts for almost half of all tooth extractions. The treatment of tooth decay by the placement of simple, direct restorations (fillings) alone costs the NHS in England & Wales £173 million per year.
- Dental restorations do not last forever; over 60% of all restorative dentistry is for the replacement of restorations.
- New restorative materials are often marketed and introduced into practice with limited evidence on their long-term clinical performance.

We developed them for use in a two day workshop that was primarily targetted at Nurses and the Professions Allied to Medicine. We had to adapt existing materials to suit our audience. The materials are unashamedly derivative of excellent work done by a whole lot of other people notably David Sackett, Brian Haynes, William Rosenberg , Scott Richardson, Trisha Greenhalgh, Muir Gray, and CASPE to name but a few.

The adaptations consist primarily of rewriting materials avoiding the the use of technical, research and medical terminology. The purpose of the workshop in which the materials are used is to provide individuals with a basic set of tools to get started with EBP. The idea is that they will then be self-sufficient enough to go away and use the materials to practice on their own with minimal support. It hasn't always worked out that way - but thats not necessarily the fault of the materials !

For experienced EBP people you may not find anything new here but for those looking for materials to use with this audience we hope you will find them useful. Please give us your feedback as we are always trying to improve them.




